## PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

### MANCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

#### City of Manchester (Blackley) Smoke Control Order 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Manchester acting by the Council of the said City in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, on the 15th day of January 1969, made an Order entitled the City of Manchester (Blackley) Smoke Control Order 1969, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order, including the exemptions referred to in paragraph 7 below, and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st April 1970, or before a later date determined under the provisions of the Clean Air Act 1956.
