PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

LONDON BOROUGH OF GREENWICH

The West Greenwich Smoke Control (Variation) Order (No. 1) 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Greenwich in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 16th day of January 1969, made an Order entitled the West Greenwich Smoke Control (Variation) Order (No. 1), 1969 (hereinafter called the "Variation Order") varying the West Greenwich Smoke Control Order 1968 (hereinafter called the "Principal Order") by the deletion from the Schedule to the said Principal Order of the buildings specified in the Schedule hereto.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Act, if on any day after the Variation Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building specified in the Schedule hereto, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Variation Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of December 1969,
