Smoke Control Order (No. 3) 1969*

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Hucknall in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 20th day of January 1969, made an Order entitled the Urban District Council of Hucknall Smoke Control Order (No. 3) 1969, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonized fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 31st day of October 1969, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Clerk of the Council, Council Offices, Watnall Road, Hucknall, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 31st day of January, 1969.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

ALDERSHOT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Aldershot (St. George's Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Aldershot Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (including loading and unloading) at all times on that part of the east side of St. George's Road from its junction with Church Lane East to the boundary between numbers 106 and 108 St. George's Road.

Exception will be provided in the Order to enable a person to alight from a vehicle, and to enable vehicles to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstructions and the maintenance to the road or the service therein.
