(c) Draycott Road, Southmoor, from its junction with the Oxford-Swindon Road (A.420) in a northerly direction to a point approximately 130 yards north of Blandy Avenue, a distance of approximately 410 yards.

(d) Blandy Avenue, Southmoor, from its junction with Draycott Road for a distance of approximately 70 yards.

(e) Cherry Tree Close, from its junction with Oxford-Swindon Road (A.420) in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 50 yards. (386)

#### BRECONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Breconshire County Council (Priory Hill and Pendre, Brecon) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1968.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 29th day of November 1968, the Breconshire County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to allow a vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight; to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; and to enable building operations or demolition and the maintenance of essential services.

This Order will come into operation on the 3rd day of February 1969.

##### *Length of road in the Borough of Brecon*

Both sides of the B.4560 (Priory Hill and Pendre, Brecon) from its junction with Trunk Road, A.438, to a point 300 yards north of its junction with the southern entrance to Peppercorn Lane. (312)

#### BRECONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Breconshire County Council (Various Streets, Hay-on-Wye) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1968.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 29th day of November 1968, the Breconshire County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles:

(a) at any time in any of the lengths or on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 hereto;

(b) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 hereto for longer than one hour in any two hours.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to allow a vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary for the purpose of boarding, alighting, loading or unloading and for funerals, building, demolition and the maintenance of essential services.

This Order will come into operation on the 3rd day of February 1969.

#### SCHEDULE 1

##### *Lengths of road in the Urban District of Hay-on-Wye in the County of Brecon*

###### 1. Brecon Road:

Both sides from a point 178 yards west of its junction with St. Mary's Road to its junction with Church Street, a distance of 244 yards.

###### 2. Church Street:

(a) both sides from its junction with Brecon Road to a point 76 yards south of its junction with St. Mary's Road, a distance of 75 yards;

(b) the north side from its junction with St. Mary's Road to a point 20 yards north-east of that junction, a distance of 20 yards;

(c) the south side from a point 13 yards south of its junction with St. Mary's Road to a point 41 yards north-east of that junction, a distance of 54 yards.

###### 3. Castle Street:

(a) the north side from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Belmont Road, a distance of 72 yards;

(b) the north side from its junction with Belmont Road to a point 15 yards north-east of that junction, a distance of 15 yards;

(c) the south side from its junction with Oxford Road to its junction with High Town, a distance of 168 yards.

###### 4. Belmont Road:

Both sides from its junction with Castle Street to its junction with Broad Street, a distance of 168 yards.

###### 5. Broad Street:

(a) the north-west side from its junction with Belmont Road to a point 13 yards north-east of that junction, a distance of 13 yards;

(b) the north-west side from its junction with Bridge Street to a point 19 yards south-west of that junction, a distance of 19 yards;

(c) the north-west side from its junction with Bridge Street to a point 15 yards north-east of that junction, a distance of 15 yards;

(d) the north-west side from its junction with Newport Street to a point 17 yards south-west of that junction, a distance of 17 yards;

(e) the south-east side from its junction with Lion Street to a point 19 yards north-east of that junction, a distance of 19 yards;

(f) the south-east side from its junction with Heol-y-Dwr to a point 47 yards south-west of that junction, a distance of 47 yards.

###### 6. Newport Street:

Both sides from its junction with Heol-y-Dwr to a point 160 yards north-east of that junction, a distance of 160 yards.

###### 7. Bridge Street:

Both sides from its junction with Broad Street to its junction with the south-eastern end of Wye Bridge, a length of 80 yards.

###### 8. Forest Road:

Both sides from its junction with Church Road/Brecon Road to a point 27 yards east of that junction, a distance of 27 yards.

###### 9. St. Mary's Road:

(a) both sides from its junction with Gipsy Castle Lane to its junction with Church Street, a distance of 235 yards also both sides of the spur for a length of 15 yards;

(b) the east side from its junction with Brecon Road to a point 48 yards north of that junction, a distance of 48 yards;

(c) the west side from its junction with Brecon Road to a point 55 yards north of that junction, a distance of 55 yards.

###### 10. Gipsy Castle Lane

Both sides from its junction with St. Mary's Road to a point 11 yards west of that junction, a distance of 11 yards.

###### 11. Heol-y-Dwr

(a) the north-east side from its junction with Broad Street, to its junction with Lion Street, a distance of 285 yards;

(b) the south-west side from its junction with Broad Street to a point 43 yards south-east of its junction with Brook Street, a distance of 140 yards;

(c) the south-west side from a point 78 yards north-west of its junction with Lion Street to that junction, a distance of 78 yards.

###### 12. Brook Street

Both sides from its junction with Heol-y-Dwr to its junction with Lion Street, a distance of 142 yards.

###### 13. Lion Street

(a) the east side from its junction with Broad Street to a point 8 yards south of that junction, a distance of 8 yards;

(b) the north side from a point 31 yards south of the junction with Broad Street to its junction with Chancery Lane, a distance of 161 yards;
