SALOP COUNTY COUNCIL

ST. HELENS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of St. Helens Traffic Regulation Order No. 1, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the St. Helens County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, providing for the regulation of traffic in a length of unnamed highway situate between the premises numbered 1 and 5 Westfield Street, which proceeds for a distance of 32 yards from Westfield Street in a southerly direction towards Brook Street.
