BOLTON COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Bolton (Great Lever) Smoke Control Order, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Bolton acting by the Council of the said Borough in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, have made the above Order declaring that except for the area which is comprised in "The Bolton (Extension of Leonard Street Estate) Smoke Control Order, 1960" the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area which Order is to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act and by the Order except for the area comprised in "The Bolton (Extension of Leonard Street Estate) Smoke Control Order, 1960", if on any day after this Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

A copy of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at my office at the Town Hall, Bolton, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 31st day of January 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT

The Brent No. 7 (Sudbury) Smoke Control Order, 1969

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st December 1969, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.
