The Trunk Road (South Mimms By-Pass, Hertfordshire) (Prohibition of Entry) Order, 1969

The Minister of Transport has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 the effect of which is to prevent any person causing any vehicle which is proceeding in that length of the London—Carlisle—Glasgow—Inverness Trunk Road (A.6), known as the South Mimms By-Pass in the Rural District of Elstree, to enter the slip road connecting the said by-pass with St. Albans Road (B.650) at the junction of the said St. Albans Road with the trunk road in the said Rural District.

The Trunk Road (Bury New Road, Prestwich) (Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1969.
