ARCHITECTS (REGISTRATION) ACT, 1931

Regulations made by the Architects Registration Council of the United Kingdom under section 13 of the above-mentioned Act have been submitted for the approval of the Privy Council and are published herewith.

Representations by persons to whom the Regulations are applicable may be made in writing to the Privy Council on or before the 7th day of May 1969.

ARCHITECTS REGISTRATION COUNCIL OF THE UNITED KINGDOM

REGULATIONS MADE IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 13 OF
THE ARCHITECTS (REGISTRATION) ACT, 1931,
AMENDING THE EXISTING REGULATIONS.

1. Amend Regulation 26 to read as follows:

"26. A person shall be eligible for registration under Section 6 (1) (d) of the principal Act if he is in the Council's opinion a fit and proper person to be so registered and satisfies any one of the requirements set out below:

- (i) that at the time of his application he has passed any examination held in pursuance of Section 6 (4) of the principal Act; or
- (ii) that within the ten years preceding his application for registration, or within such longer period as the Council may in their discretion approve in respect of any individual application, he has passed an examination in architecture which was then recognised by the Council under Section 6 (1) (c) of the principal Act; or
- (iii) that he holds at the time of his application the valid Certificate issued by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards
