CIVIC AMENITIES ACT, 1967

Barnard Castle—Designation of Conservation Area

Notice is hereby given that on 7th May 1969, the Durham County Council in pursuance of their powers under section 1 of the Civic Amenities Act, 1967 designated as a Conservation Area that part of Barnard Castle described in the Schedule hereto

This area has been designated as a Conservation Area because it includes most of the buildings of architectural and historic interest in the town, ancient monuments, the castle ruins, the mediaeval street framework and the supporting landscape

A plan showing the area designated has been placed on deposit at the offices of the Barnard Castle Urban

District Council, "Woodleigh", Barnard Castle, and at County Hall, Durham (Room 1/19) and may be inspected there during normal office hours.

SCHEDULE

The whole of the historic area of the town, including Galgate, Horsemarket, Market Place, The Bank, Thorngate, Bridgegate, Newgate, Bahol Street, Marshall Street, Flatts Road, King's Street, Queen's Street, the south side of Birch Road, the Bowes Museum, the Barnard Castle School, the Demesne and the whole of the frontage of the River Tees from the Percy Beck in the north-west to the Sewage Works in the south-east
