Any person may make application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made if he desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of sections 28 and 84D of the aforementioned Act or on the ground that any requirement of the said sections 28 and 84D or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with.
