By Royal Licence and Authority having date the 25th day of April 1969 Her Majesty has been pleased to give and grant unto Ian Lionel Spencer Inigo Jones, Esquire, formerly Ian Lionel Spencer Horne of Ryley's Farm, Grittleton in the county of Wiltshire that he and his issue may take and assume and bear and use the Arms of Inigo Jones quarterly with the Arms of Horne, and that he and they may in like manner take and assume and bear and use the crest of Inigo Jones with the crest of Horne, the whole according to the Laws of Arms the said Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms, otherwise Her Majesty's said Royal Licence and permission to be void and none effect. PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

Wages and Conditions in the Electrical Contracting Industry

Direction under section 5 (4) further extending the period within which the National Board for Prices and Incomes must publish their report.

Whereas the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pursuance of her powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, referred the abovementioned question to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for Prices and In and Incomes for examination and has published the text of the reference in the Gazette on 13th December

1968;
2. And whereas by section 5 (3) of the Act, but subject to section 5 (4), the Board are required to make their report so as to allow publication within three months of the said date;
3. And whereas, in pursuance of her powers under the said section 5 (4), the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, by a direction published in the Gazette on 13th March 1969, extended the said period of three months by three months;
4. Now therefore the First Secretary of State

4. Now, therefore, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pursuance of her powers under the said section 5 (4), hereby directs that the said period of three months be further extended by one month.

PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

REPORT BY THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

The Pay Settlement reached on 1st December 1968 between the Newspaper Publishers' Association and the National Union of Journalists.

On 11th March 1969, in pursuance of her powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary
