NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Norfolk (Mundesley) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Norfolk County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be as follows:

- (i) to prohibit the driving of vehicles on the undermentioned length of road at Mundesley save in the direction set out below:

<i>Road</i>	<i>Direction</i>
High Street from junction Station Road to junction Back Street.	From north to south.

- (ii) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on any of the lengths of road at Mundesley specified in the First Schedule hereto;
- (iii) to limit the waiting of vehicles to 20 minutes in any hour in the length of road at Mundesley specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads or the services therein, or as part of a funeral cortege.

Objections to such Order together with the grounds on which they are made, should be sent to the undersigned not later than the 8th July 1969.

The Portsmouth (Fountain Street) (Restrictions on Waiting) (No. 8) Order, 1969
