PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966 REPORT BY THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

A settlement and certain proposals relating to the pay of workers employed in the exhibition industry

On 18th March 1969, in pursuance of her powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity referred to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for their examination and report:

- the settlement reached on 7th February 1969 by the National Joint Council for the Exhibition Industry providing, amongst other things, for—
 - (a) increases in the hourly rates of wages of craftsmen and labourers of fourpence and threepence respectively; and
 - (b) a productivity bonus of ten shillings per day (including week-end working) for all operatives covered by the said National Joint Council employed in shops and exhibition halls;

(2) the proposals made on 28th February 1969 by the employers' side to the operatives' side of

the National Exhibition Electrical Joint Industrial Council offering, amongst other things-

(a) increases in the hourly rates of wages of

(a) increases in the hourly rates of wages of journeymen electricians and adult mates of fivepence and fourpence respectively; and (b) a productivity bonus of ten shillings per day (including week-end working) for all operatives covered by the said Joint Industrial Council employed in shops and exhibition hells. tion halls.

The Board has now made its report entitled "Pay and Conditions of Workers in the Exhibition Contracting Industry". In accordance with section 5 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity hereby gives notice that the report was first published as Command Paper Number 4088 on 18th June 1969.
