Lengths of road in the County Borough of West Bromwich

- (a) Union Street (WED). Both sides, from a point 67 yards west of the junction of Union Street and High Street to the junction of Union Street and High Street.
 - (b) High Street (WED). Both sides, from a point 67 yards west of the junction of High Street and Walsall Street to the junction of High Street and Walsall Street.
 - (c) Walsall Street (WED). Both sides, from a point 67 yards north of the junction of Walsall Street and High Street to the junction of Walsall Street and High Street.
 - (d) Market Place (WED). Both sides, from the junction of Market Place and Shambles to the junction of Market Place and Walsall Street.
- 2. (a) Union Street (WED). Both sides, from the junction of Union Street and Camp Street to the junction of Union Street and High Bullen.
 - (b) Camphill Lane. Both sides, from the junction of Camphill Lane and Loxdale Street to the junction of Camphill Lane and Union Street.

- 5. (a) Sedgley Road East. Both sides, from a point 67 yards west of the junction of Sedgley Road East and Dudley Port to a point 67 yards east of the junction of Sedgley Road East and Dudley Port.
 - (b) Dudley Port. Both sides, from a point 67 yards north of the junction of Sedgley Road East and Dudley Port to a point 67 yards south of the junction of Sedgley Road East and Dudley Port.
- 6. (a) Powis Avenue. Both sides, from a point 67 yards west of the junction of Powis Avenue and Upper Church Lane to a point 67 yards east of the junction of Powis Avenue and Upper Church Lane.
 - (b) Upper Church Lane. Both sides, from a point 67 yards north of the junction of Powis Avenue and Upper Church Lane to a point 67 yards south of the junction of Powis Avenue and Upper Church Lane.
- (a) Newton Road. Both sides, from a point 115 yards west of the junction of Newton Road and Birmingham Road to the junction of Birmingham Road and Newton Road.
 - (b) Birmingham Road (A.34). Both sides, from a point 85 yards north of the junction of Birming-ham Road and Queslett Road to the junction of Birmingham Road and Queslett Road.
 - (c) Queslett Road. Both sides, from a point 90 yards east of the junction of Queslett Road and Walsali Road to the junction of Queslett Road and the Walsali Road.
 - l) Walsall Road. Both sides, from a point 125 yards south of the junction of Walsall Road and Queslett Road to the junction of Walsall Road and Queslett Road. (d) Walsall Road.

WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Wilts. (High Street (Pt.), Corsham) (Restriction of Driving) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the length of High Street, Corsham, between its junction with Pickwick Road/Lacock Road and its junction with Church Street. This restriction will not apply if the vehicle is being Lacock Road and its junction with Church Street. This restriction will not apply if the vehicle is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to (i) the length of High Street, between its junction with Pickwick Road/Lacock Road and its junction with Priory Street and (ii) on the length its junction with Priory Street and (11) on the length of Priory Street from its junction with High Street for a distance of 100 yards in a westerly direction. The usual exemptions will apply to vehicles used in connection with the maintenance of the road, and building operations, and work in connection with statutory undertakers apparatus.
