NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE
COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949*Suffolk Coast and Heaths Areas of Outstanding
Natural Beauty (Designation) Order*

Notice is hereby given that the Countryside Commission propose to make and submit to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation the above-mentioned Order.

2. The effect of the proposed Order, which will not come into operation until confirmed by the Minister of Housing and Local Government, will be to constitute the land to which the proposed Order relates areas of outstanding natural beauty for the purposes of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949.

3. The proposed Order relates to land situated in the County of East Suffolk and comprises land within the undermentioned districts:

The Municipal Corporations of Aldeburgh and Southwold

The Urban Districts of Felixstowe, Leiston-cum-Sizewell, and Woodbridge

The Rural Districts of Blyth, Deben, Lothingland, Samford, and Wainford.

4. A copy of the proposed Order and of the map referred to therein has been deposited for public inspection at the offices of the Council of each of the areas mentioned above, and will be open for inspection free of charge during office hours. Copies may also be inspected at the offices of the Countryside Commission, 1 Cambridge Gate, Regent's Park, London N.W.1.

Any representations with reference to the proposed Order should be sent in writing to the Secretary, Countryside Commission, 1 Cambridge Gate, Regent's Park, London N.W.1, so as to arrive not later than the 2nd day of August 1969 and any such representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
