NOTICE TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

BEBINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Bebington (Area No. 20—Stage II)
Smoke Control Order 1969*

Notice is hereby given that the Bebington Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 17th June 1969, made an Order entitled "The Borough of Bebington (Area No. 20—Stage II) Smoke Control Order, 1969" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order comes into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Bebington, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 4th July 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

The City and County of Bristol (Clifton) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turns) Order, 1969
