

4. The whole length of road which comprises the roundabout, known as Station Roundabout, which connects Rectory Road, Chorleywood Road and Park Road.

5. That length of Chorleywood Road which extends from its junction with the roundabout that forms its junction with Rectory Road and Park Road in a north-westerly direction, for a distance measured along the said length of road of 307 yards.

ROTHERHAM COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Rotherham (Albion Road)
