

(b) that the two lengths of the London—Penzance Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be trunk roads as from the 1st April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the County Council of Somerset (who will become the highway authority responsible for those lengths) that the new trunk road is open for through traffic; and

2. an Order under section 9 of the above Act authorising the Minister—

- (a) to carry out improvements to Cheshays Hill (A.358),
- (b) to stop up three lengths of the Trunk Road, and
- (c) to construct a new highway to connect the new trunk road with the above-mentioned Trunk Road, all at Horton Cross aforesaid, and

providing for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Somerset as from the date on which the Minister notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

Warboys, Somersham and Pidley Internal Drainage District

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4 (3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Great Ouse River Authority, under section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, making provision for:

- (i) the constitution of the Warboys, Somersham and Pidley Internal Drainage District and of the Drainage Board thereof;
- (ii) the alteration of the boundaries of the Ramsey First Internal Drainage District;
- (iii) the abolition of the Warboys (United District) Drainage District and of the Commissioners thereof;
- (iv) the abolition of the Somersham and Pidley (Fourth District) Drainage District and of the Commissioners thereof;
- (v) the abolition of the Chatteris and Somersham (Lower District) Drainage District and of the Commissioners thereof;
- (vi) the making of alterations in the provisions of certain local Acts; and
- (vii) matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

The Scheme affects lands in the Urban District of Chatteris and the Parishes of Benwick and Doddington in the Rural District of North Witchford in the County of Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely, and lands in the Urban District of Ramsey and the Parishes of Pidley cum Fenton, Somersham and Warboys in the Rural District of St. Ives in the County of Huntingdon and Peterborough.

WATER RESOURCES ACT, 1963
