The road leading from the Broad Oak-Cross House Road near Charles Ground to the west of Duddon Bridge-Ulpha Road near Logan Beck.

The road leading from the Levens Bridge-Carlisle Trunk Road A.595 west of Duddon Bridge to the east of Duddon Bridge-Cockley Beck Bridge Road near Ulpha Bridge.

##### SCHEDULE 1

##### No Waiting at any time

Station Road (A.592)—east side—from junction with Castlegate for a distance of 138 yards in a southerly direction.

Station Road (A.592)—west side—from junction with Cromwell Road for a distance of 98 yards in a southerly direction.

Castlegate (A.6)—south side—from junction with Station Road for a distance of 61 yards in an easterly direction.

Cromwell Road (A.6)—south side—from junction with Station Road for a distance of 23 yards in a westerly direction.

##### SCHEDULE 2

##### No Waiting—7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Friargate—west side—from junction with Benson's Row to 20 yards north of junction with Old London Road—a distance of 264 yards.

Friargate—east side—from junction with Benson's Row to 31 yards south of junction.

Burrowgate—11 yards on south-west and 8 yards on south-east side of the conveniences.

Lane between Burrowgate and Devonshire Street—east side—from junction with Devonshire Street to 37 yards north of junction with Devonshire Street.

Lane between Burrowgate and Devonshire Street—west side—from junction with Devonshire Street to 31 yards north of junction with Devonshire Street.

Benson's Row—south-west side—

(a) from its junction with Friargate, south-east—a distance of 46 yards.

(b) From its junction with Friargate, north-west—a distance of 23 yards.

Great Dockray—south-west side—from junction with West Lane for a distance of 77 yards in a north-easterly direction.

(Existing Restriction—No Waiting at Any Time.)

Great Dockray—north-east side—

(a) From its junction with Corn Market to its junction with Angel Lane—a distance of 48 yards.

(b) From its junction with Angel Lane to its junction with Princes Street—a distance of 38 yards.

(Lengths (a) and (b)—Existing Restriction—No Waiting at Any Time.)

Corn Market—south-east side—from junction with Great Dockray to 6 yards north-east of junction with Great Dockray.

(Existing Restriction—No Waiting at Any Time.)

Castle Drive—east side—from junction with Ullswater Road (A.592) north to its junction with Castle Terrace—a distance of 428 yards.

Neville Avenue—west side—

(a) From its junction with West Lane to its junction with Warwick Place—a distance of 34 yards.

(b) From its junction with Warwick Place to its junction with Castle Terrace—a distance of 47 yards.

Queen Street—south-west side—from junction with Hunter's Lane—a distance of 13 yards in a south-easterly direction.

(Existing Restriction—Waiting Limited to One Hour.)

Market Place—south-east side—from its junction with Rowcliffe Lane for a distance of 6 yards in a south-westerly direction.

Market Place—south-west side—from its junction with Angel Lane for a distance of 8 yards in a north-westerly direction.

##### SCHEDULE 3

##### Waiting Limited to One Hour in Any Three— 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Friargate—east side—from a point 31 yards south of its junction with Benson's Row to 20 yards north of the junction with Old London Road—a distance of 227 yards.

West Lane—south-west side—

(a) From a point 37 yards north-west of its junction with Castle Drive to Neville Avenue—a distance of 56 yards.

(b) From junction with Neville Avenue for a distance of 43 yards in a north-westerly direction.

(Length (a)—Existing Restriction—No Waiting 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.)

Corn Market—south-east side—from a point 6 yards from its junction with Great Dockray for a distance of 7 yards in a north-easterly direction.

(Existing Restriction—No Waiting at Any Time.)

##### SCHEDULE 4

##### Waiting Limited to 30 Minutes in Any Hour— 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Sandgate—south-west side—from its junction with St. Andrew's View for a distance of 74 yards in a north-westerly direction.

Burrowgate—south-east side—from a point 37 yards north of its junction with Devonshire Street for a distance of 27 yards in a north-easterly direction.

Burrowgate—south-west side—from a point 31 yards north of its junction with Devonshire Street for a distance of 27 yards in a north-westerly direction.

Corn Market—south-west side—from junction with Castlegate for a distance of 26 yards in a south-easterly direction.

(Existing Restriction—No Waiting at Any Time.)
