## DURHAM COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Durham (Various Streets, Aycliffe Industrial Estate) Prohibition of Waiting Order, 1969.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Durham have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the sides of roads specified in the Schedule below except with the acceptance of a police. upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform.

There are exemptions to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded, to enable a vehicle, under certain conditions, to be used in connection with building or other operations or in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage.
