

Worsley Village Conservation Area—comprising an area bounded by the existing and proposed motorway on the west, Worsley Brook on the north, an irregular line from Mill Brown to Barton Road on the east, and Barton Road to the proposed motorway on the south, as shown on Plan No. A/10/26/79 which can be inspected at the Divisional Planning Office, 274 Deansgate, Manchester and the Town Hall, Worsley.

Withnell Fold Conservation Area—comprising an area bounded by Blackburn Road on the east, a line following a narrow band of woodland to the south of the Recreation Ground on the south, the valley of the River Lostock and the Leeds/Liverpool Canal on the west, and an irregular line from the Leeds/Liverpool Canal to Blackburn Road on the north, as shown on the Plan No. A/10/18/82, which can be inspected at the Divisional Planning Office, 18 Bridgeman Terrace, Wigan and the Council Offices, School Lane, Brinscall.

Lancaster Castle Precinct Conservation Area—comprising an area bounded by the main railway on the west, the Green Ayre railway link on the north, Cable Street, New Road and New Street on the east, and Market Street and Meeting House Lane on the south, as shown on Plan No. A/10/80 which can be inspected at the Divisional Planning Office, 58 Scotforth Road, Lancaster and the Town Hall, Lancaster.

Notice is hereby given that the Breconshire County Council, following consultation with the Crickhowell Rural District Council, has determined in accordance with section 1 of the Civic Amenities Act 1967 that Crickhowell and Llangattock, being an area the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance, shall be designated as a Conservation Area.

The area comprises that section of the A.40 Trunk Road, in Crickhowell extending from the Crown Inn, Pen-y-dre to the Green; Standard Street, including Upper House Farm; New Road, including Porth Mawr; Castle Road, High Street, Bridge Street; Crickhowell Bridge and the river and meadows immediately up and downstream; and on the Llangattock side of the Usk, the area between and including the Vine Tree, Beechwood, the Plas, Garn Goch, Glan Onneu, Six Bells, St. Cattwg's Church, the Rectory and the Cwrt.

The Conservation Area plan has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours, at the office of the Crickhowell Rural District Council, Beaufort Street, Crickhowell and at the County Planning Department, 6 Glamorgan Street, Brecon.
