LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

The Somerset River Authority River Tone Navigation

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 41 of the Land Drainage Act 1930 has made an Order varying three local Acts dated respectively 1699 (10 and 11 William III), 1708 (6 Anne) and 1804 (44 George III c. 83) and relating to navigation functions over the River Tone so that such functions shall cease to apply to such part of the River Tone as lies between the junction of that river with the Bridgwater and Taunton Canal at Taunton and the confluence of the said river with the River Parrett at Stanmoor Bridge.

The Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless within thirty-one days from the date of the publication of this Notice a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial, praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.

A copy of the sealed Order has been deposited at the office of the Clerk of the Somerset River Authority, 12 King Square, Bridgwater, Somerset, for public inspection for a period of thirty-one days from the date of publication of this notice and may be inspected during normal office hours.
