to prohibit waiting from 1st April to 30th September inclusive each year on the following sides of lengths of road and length of road in the Parish of Coniston in the Rural District of

North Lonsdale:

(i) The north side of Hawkshead Road B.5285, from its junction with Yewdale Road A.593 for 225 feet in an easterly direction.

(b) to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles in the following road and length of road in the Parish of Coniston in the Rural District of North Lonsdale:—

(ii) The Garth;
(ii) Ruskin Avenue, from a point 270 feet south-east of its junction with Hawkshead Road B.5285 to the south-easterly end of Ruskin Avenue,

The Order in so far as it relates to (b) above will contain exemptions to allow the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any adjacent premises; for the purposes of agriculture or timber felling; and in connection with any building operation or demolition and the maintenance of essential services.

(1) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times

- (b) the loading or unloading of any vehicle while the vehicle is in actual use in con-nection with the collection or delivery of goods which cannot reasonably be loaded or unloaded outside the hours specified in this proviso provided that notice is given 24 hours in advance to the police and their consent obtained.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council propose to make an Order under sections I and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be:

(A) to amend The Lancashire County Council (Main Street and Lindale Road, Grange-over-Sands) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1969, so that the waiting of vehicles will be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily throughout the year on the following sides of lengths of road in the Urban District of Grange:

North-west side of Main Street from the Clock Tower to a point 30 yards south-west of its junction with Morecambe Bank.

North-west side of Main Street from a point 16 yards north-east of its junction with Morecambe Bank to a point 86 yards north-east of that junc-

North-west side of Main Street from a point 106 yards north-east of its junction with Morecambe Bank to a point 90 yards south-west of its junction with Lindale Road.

South-east side of Main Street from the Clock

South-east side of Main Street from the Clock Tower to a point 111 yards north-east of its junction with Morecambe Bank.

South-east side of Main Street from a point 141 yards north-east of its junction with Morecambe Bank to a point 226 yards south-west of its junction with Lindale Road.

South-east side of Main Street from its junction with Lindale Road for a distance of 108 yards in a south-westerly direction.

South side of Lindale Road from its junction with Main Street for a distance of 17 yards in an easterly direction.

The exemptions in the said Order of 1969 will still be applicable. At present the waiting of vehicles on the above-mentioned sides of lengths of road is prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from the 1st October until the 30th April and between the hours of 8 a.m and 8 p.m. from the 1st May to the 30th September annually.

(B) to restrict the waiting of vehicles to 30 minutes in any period of one hour between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on either of the following sides of lengths of road:

The north-westerly side of Main Street, Grange, from a point 86 yards north-east of its junction
