The amendment becomes operative as from 8th August 1969, but if any person aggrieved by it desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within six weeks from 8th August 1969, make application to the High Court.

The proposals dealt with in the amendment comprise amendments to the Town Map in respect of a new road pattern, the defining of approximately 19 acres of land in the centre of Blaydon as an area of comprehensive development and the designation of approximately 5.23 acres of such land as subject to compulsory purchase. It is intended that the Comprehensive Development Area will be redeveloped primarily to provide a new shopping precinct, offices, public buildings, a bus interchange point and car parks.
