

HAZEL GROVE AND BRAMHALL URBAN  
DISTRICT COUNCIL*The Hazel Grove (No. 5) Smoke Control Order,*  
1969

Notice is hereby given that the Hazel Grove and Bramhall Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 29th day of July 1969, made an Order entitled "The Hazel Grove (No. 5) Smoke Control Order, 1969", declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupant of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st November 1970, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order, and of the map referred to therein, may be inspected free of charge at The Council House, Hazel Grove, at any reasonable time during the period of six weeks from the 21st August 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

## SCHEDULE

The area within a line drawn from the junction of Torkington Road and London Road, Hazel Grove, in a north westerly direction along the centre of London Road to the urban district boundary; then in a north easterly direction following the urban district boundary to Bean Leach Road; then in a southerly direction at the rear of the houses in Farnon Avenue (odd numbers) to Bosden Fold Road; then in an easterly direction to the junction of Bosden Fold Road and Hazelwood Road; then in a southerly direction along the centre of Hazelwood Road to the junction of Hazelwood Road and Torkington Road; then in a south-westerly direction to the starting point at London Road.

Notice is hereby given that the Lincoln City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 31st day of July 1969, made an Order entitled the City of Lincoln (No. 3) Smoke Control Order 1969 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of same was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Corporation Offices, Saltergate, Lincoln, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 15th day of August 1969.

## ROCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

## CLEAN AIR ACTS, 1956 AND 1968

*The City of Rochester (No. 5) Smoke Control*  
Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and citizens of the City of Rochester (acting by the Council) in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (the principal Act) on the 29th day of July 1969, made an Order entitled "The City of Rochester (No. 5) Smoke Control Order, 1969", declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the principal Act:

(i) if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel.

(ii) any person who acquires any unauthorised solid fuel for use in a building or for use in a boiler or plant in the smoke control area or who sells by retail any unauthorised solid fuel for delivery by him or on his behalf to a building or to premises in which there is a boiler or industrial plant, in the smoke control area shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless, in the case of a person who sells by retail for delivery, he proves that he believed and had reasonable grounds for believing that either

- (a) the building was an exempted building, or
- (b) the buyer intended to use the fuel in an exempted fireplace, boiler or plant.

The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of July 1970, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Guildhall, Rochester, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 22nd August 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

## SCHEDULE

In the City of Rochester, the area having boundaries as follows:

From the northern extremity of the city boundary on Cliffe Road, down the middle of Cliffe Road in a southerly direction to Frindsbury Road, thence along the middle of Frindsbury Road in a south-westerly direction to North Street and continuing in a southerly direction down the middle of North Street until meeting the London-Rochester railway line, thence following the centre of the railway line in a westerly direction until meeting the north-east boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 4, thence following this boundary in a westerly direction along the middle of Watling Street until reaching a point where the city boundary bears north, thence following the northern boundary of the city until reaching the aforementioned northern extremity on Cliffe Road.
