The Unnamed Road between Savile Street at a point 448 feet south-west of the south-western kerb line of Sutherland Street and Attercliffe Road at a point 670 feet west of the south-western kerb line of Sutherland Street.

2. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) in the following lengths or parts of road:

Leadmill Road

(i) the west side between a point 180 feet south of Sheaf Square and a point 350 feet south of Sheaf Square;

(ii) the east side between a point 220 feet south of Sheaf Square and a point 325 feet south of Sheaf Square.

(ii) the north-west side between the north-eastern kerb line of Heppenstall Lane and the south-

western kerb line of Colwall Street.

Main Road

(i) the south-west side between Staniforth Road and the western kerb line of Beighton Street;

(ii) the north-east side between Staniforth Road and a point 84 feet south-east of the south-eastern kerb line of Greenland Road.

Savile Street the south-east side between its junction with the Wicker and a point 140 feet north-east of the north-eastern edge of the viaduct known as Wicker Arches.

(i) between the south-eastern kerb line of Attercliffe Road and the northern kerb line of Roundel Street;

(ii) between Main Road and the eastern kerb line of Irving Street/Kirby Road.

4. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles outside the periods between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) at any time on Saturdays and Sundays in the following lengths or parts of road:

Ecclesall Road South

(i) the south-east side between the north-eastern kerb line of Carter Knowle Road and a point 115 feet north-east of that kerb line;

(ii) the south-east side between the south-western kerb line of Carter Knowle Road and a point 105 feet south-west of that kerb line;

(iii) the south-east side from a point 193 feet south-west of its junction with Carter Knowle Road for a distance of 130 feet in a southwesterly direction;

(iii) the south-west side between the south-eastern kerb line of Holme Lane and a point 50 feet north-west of the western kerb line of Forbes Road.

Mansfield Road the north-east side of the north-east carriageway between a point 370 feet north-west of the north-western kerb line of the lane adjacent to No. 13A Mansfield Road and a point 440 feet north-west of that kerb line.
