## MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES AND FOOD

### SALMON AND FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACT 1923

#### *The Bristol Avon River Authority Area*

Whereas the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has settled and made the Bristol Avon River Authority (Fisheries) Order 1969, under Part IV of the Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries Act 1923, enabling the said River Authority to fix by byelaw the annual trout close season for rod and line so that it commences later than 1st October but not later than 1st November in each year.

Now notice is hereby given that such Order will be confirmed and will thereupon become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless a Memorial is presented to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food on or before 22nd September 1969 by a river authority, local authority or other person or association affected by such Order praying that the Order shall be subject to special Parliamentary procedure.
