CAMBRIDGESHIRE AND ISLE OF ELY
COUNTY COUNCIL*The County of Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely (North Street, Wisbech) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969*

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely, County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to revoke the existing waiting restrictions in North Street and North Terrace, Wisbech and prohibit waiting at any time in the length of North Street, Wisbech described in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions are contained in the Order to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle and to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with building operations, demolition, the maintenance of the road and public utility services.

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 the effect of which will be to institute one way traffic working in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice, traffic to proceed in the direction specified in the said Schedule.

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to:

- (a) Prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice.
- (b) Limit the waiting of vehicles to 30 minutes in any hour in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice.
