- (b) between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in either of the lengths or on either of the sides of road specified in Schedule
- (c) between 8 a.m. and 9.15 a.m., 12 noon and 1.30 p.m. or 4.30 p.m. and 7 p.m. on any day other than on Sunday in either of the lengths or on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 hereto; and
- (d) for more than 30 minutes in any hour:
 - (i) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in the lay-by lying on the north-west side of the said trunk road at its junction with Clumber Street;
 - (ii) between 12 midnight and 8 a.m., and 12 noon, 1.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. or 7 p.m. and 12 midnight on any day other than a Sunday or at any time on any Sunday on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 4 hereto; or
 - (iii) between 9.15 a.m. and 12 noon or 1.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of road specified in Schedule 5 hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein. The Order will also exempt disabled drivers from the time limits where limited waiting is permitted.
