#### GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Gloucestershire County Council (Various Roads in Parishes of Dyrham and Hinton, Tormarton, Acton Turville and Marshfield) (Weight Restriction) (Variation) Order, 1969.*

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from 27th August 1969, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
