Northern/southern arm, western side—entire length.

Eastern side—between the junction with the eastern/western arm of Kent Road and a point in line with the boundary wall of Nos. 25-26 Kent Road.

The Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting and Loading (Guildford) (Amendment) Order 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Guildford Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 28 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and all other powers then enabling the effect of which will be as follows:

Swainson Place. On both sides of the road.

Swainson Street. From its junction with Victoria Road to its junction with Raby Road on both sides of the road.

Avenue Road. From its junction with Victoria Road to its junction with Middleton Grange Lane on the east side of the road.

Middleton Grange Lane. For a distance of 45 feet in a westerly direction from its junction with Swainson Street on the south side of the road and for a distance of 45 feet in an easterly direction from its junction with Avenue Road on the south side of the road.

Lucan Street. On the south side of the road.

Thornton Street. From its junction with Stockton Street to the western end of the temporary access ramp to the Shopping Centre on both sides of the road.

Back York Road (East). From its junction with Victoria Road to the access ramp to the Shopping Centre on both sides of the road.
