THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS, 1968

Norway : Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations of 1968, he hereby varies the recognition of the Official Certificates reproduced in Part II of the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 12th August 1938 for the importation of meat and meat products from Norway to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Recognition of the Official Certificate is extended to include:

- the tongue from any bovine animal from which a submaxillary lymphatic gland has been removed;
- portions of carcasses, with or without bone, comprising recognisable wholesale or retail cuts which contain no associated lymphatic gland or from which has been removed, in preparing or trimming of the meat any lymphatic gland, or any part of the pleura or of the peritoneum.

Recognition does not extend to boneless veal appearing to an authorised officer to be from calves less than three months old.
