*Littlehampton: River Arun Road Bridge*

*The Enfield (Restriction of Through Traffic)  
Experimental Traffic Order 1969*

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967—SECTION 12

*The Temporary Restriction of Traffic (Tower Hamlets) (No. 2) Order 1969*
