PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

REPORT BY THE
NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

*The remuneration of workers engaged in the porter-
age, handling and checking of meat and poultry
in the Smithfield Market, London, and in its
transport from the Market.*

On 24th April 1969, in pursuance of their powers
under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act
1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of
State for Employment and Productivity and the
Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, referred
to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for
their examination and report:

(1) the remuneration and conditions of workers in
the Smithfield Market (hereinafter referred to as
"the Market"), being either employees or self-
employed persons, engaged in any of the follow-
ing operations:

(a) the unloading, checking and carrying of
meat and poultry from delivery vehicles to
stalls in the Market (including the handling
of meat and poultry preparatory to un-
loading);
