The Trunk Road (Various Slip Roads, Pembroke) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is that:

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in a northerly direction in either of the parts of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice; and
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in a south-westerly direction in the part of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

SCHEDULE 1

Parts of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A.40) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") in the County of Pembroke.

1. That part of the trunk road, at Cornerpiece, which comprises a slip road for south-bound traffic entering the main carriageway of the trunk road, and which extends from its junction with the eastern side of the main carriageway of the trunk road to a point 80 yards north of that junction.
2. That part of the trunk road, at Glanafon, which comprises a slip road for south-bound traffic entering the main carriageway of the trunk road, and which extends from a point 22 yards north-east of its junction with the eastern side of the main carriageway of the trunk road to a point 112 yards north of that junction.

SCHEDULE 2

That part of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A.40) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") at Glanafon in the County of Pembroke which comprises a slip road for north-bound traffic leaving the main carriageway of the trunk road, and which extends from its junction with the eastern side of the main carriageway of the trunk road to a point 24 yards north-east of that junction.
