

CHELTENHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Cheltenham (General Traffic Control) (Variation No. 3) Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Cheltenham Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 28 jointly of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 (which Act of 1967, so amended, is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") by virtue of section 5(1) of the Act of 1967 under sections 5(2), 31(1), 53 and 84D(1) of the Act of 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the disc parking zone in the central area of Cheltenham, as follows:

- (a) between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m. on any day, not being a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday in parts of Clarence Street, Rodney Road, Albion Street, Winchcombe Street, Bennington Street, High Street, Ormond Place and Regent Street; and
(b) at all times in parts of St. George's Road, St. George's Place and Well Walk.

The Order proposes to make consequential amendments to Schedule 4 of The Borough of Cheltenham (General Traffic Control) Order, 1964, as amended, the effect of which would be to remove certain disc parking places from the terms of the Order and to impose waiting restrictions of varying duration on the lengths of disc parking places which are proposed to be so removed.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order so far as the waiting restrictions are concerned to enable a vehicle to wait with Police permission or for passengers to board or alight, for the loading or unloading of goods and for enabling works to be carried out in or adjacent to the road, and for certain other purposes.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a Statement of the Council's reasons for the proposal, and a map showing the roads and parts of roads to which the proposed Order relates, may be inspected at my office during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals specifying the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the under-signed by Monday, 6th April 1970.

*The County Council of Chester (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 5) Order 1970**Imposition of 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit on Hind Heath Road, Sandbach*

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th March 1970, the Cheshire County Council made an Order under section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice will become subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h. The Chigwell Urban District (One-Way) (Amendment No. 1) Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of the Urban District of Chigwell in the County of Essex on the 2nd March 1970, made the above-mentioned Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

CORBY URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Urban District Council of Corby (Clearway) Order, 1970

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Polperro) (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order, 1970

This notice supersedes that published on the 20th February 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to amend the County of Cornwall (Polperro) (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1969, so as to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. daily during the period from the 1st May to 30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to allow a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to allow a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable vehicles to be used in connection with building operations, the maintenance or improvement of the lengths of road or of the services therein; to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage and in connection with a funeral.

Objections to this proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 3rd April 1970.
