## DARLINGTON COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The County Borough of Darlington (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970*

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th March 1970 the Darlington County Borough Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit (with certain exceptions) waiting by all types of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.

## DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Derbyshire County Council (Various Streets, Clay Cross) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1970.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 26th February 1970, the Derbyshire County Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part 9 of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and midnight on:

*Thanet Street* on the south side from its junction with the trunk road A.61 to a point 48 yards east of its junction with Denham Street. On the north side from its junction with the trunk road A.61 for a distance of 150 yards, and from its junction with Broadleys for a distance of 10 yards and in an easterly direction for a distance of 17 yards, and from its junction with Bestwood Park in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 yards and in an easterly direction for a distance of 48 yards.

*Broadleys* from its junction with Thanet Street for a distance of 10 yards.

*Bestwood Park* from its junction with Thanet Street for a distance of 10 yards.

*Flaxpiece Road* from its junction with Thanet Street for a distance of 15 yards.

*Commonpiece Road* from its junction with Thanet Street for a distance of 5 yards.

*Cross Street* from its junction with Thanet Street for a distance of 5 yards.

In Thanet Street on the north side from a point 150 yards east of its junction with the trunk road A.61 for a distance of 60 yards, waiting will be limited between the hours of 8 a.m. and midnight to 30 minutes with a prohibition on return within one hour.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of the road, and the supply of gas, electricity and water.

The Order will come into operation on the 1st April 1970, when that part of the (Various Streets, Clay Cross) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969, relating to Thanet Street will be revoked.
