Sergeant Moore found himself trapped in the force of the waynend westel with the Series. the foc'sle of the upturned vessel with two Senior Aircraftmen. They were in darkness and with the normal exit totally obstructed. There had been no time for the crew to don life-jackets or take other safety measures. Sergeant Moore instantly
