PAY: AND OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF

EMPLOYMENT OF WORKERS IN THE POTTERY INDUSTRY Direction under section 5 (4) further extending the period within which the National Board for Prices

and Incomes must publish their report.

1.
