*The Draft Local Loans (Increase of Limit) Order, 1970*

local authorities and other eligible borrowers from £2,000 million to £3,000 million as from 1st September 1970.

Whereas a Representation duly made to Her Majesty in Council by the Minister of Housing and Local Government that, for the protection of the Public Health, burials should be discontinued as hereinafter directed in Otterbourne Old Churchyard, in the County of Hampshire, which is shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto, has in pursuance of an Order in Council made the 28th day of April 1970, and duly published, been taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the Burial Act 1853 (1853 c. 134) and of all other powers Her enabling, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. Burials shall be discontinued forthwith and entirely in Otterbourne Old Churchyard, in the County of Hampshire, which is shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto.

2. This Order may be cited as the Burial Grounds (Otterbourne Old Churchyard, Hampshire) Order 1970.
