A PROCLAMATION

ELIZABETH R.

Whereas by section 1 of the Emergency Powers Act 1920, as amended by the Emergency Powers Act 1964, it is enacted that if it appears to Us that there 1964, it is enacted that if it appears to Us that there have occurred or are about to occur events of such a nature as to be calculated, by interfering with the supply and distribution of food, water, fuel or light, or with the means of locomotion, to deprive the community, or any substantial portion of the community, of the essentials of life, We may, by Proclamation, declare that a state of emergency exists:

And whereas the present stoppage of work among persons employed in the ports does, in Our opinion, constitute a state of emergency within the meaning of the said Act of 1920, as so amended:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the said Act of 1920, as so amended, We do, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, hereby declare that a state of emergency exists.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace this sixteenth day of July, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and seventy, and in the nineteenth year of Our Reign.
