OLDHAM COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Oldham (Various Streets) (One-Way Traffic) Order No. 1, 1970

Notice is hereby given that on the 23rd day of July 1970, the Oldham County Borough Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is to institute one-way traffic in (a) Waterloo Street (from Gas Street to Union Street); (b) Gas Street (from Southgate Street to Waterloo Street); (c) Southgate Street (from Union Street to Gas Street); (d) Ashworth Street (from Clegg Street to Southgate Street); (e) Clegg Street (from Cromwell Street to Union Street); (f) Cromwell Street (from a point 320 feet west of Oliver Street to Clegg Street); (g) Cromwell Street (from Hobson Street to Brunswick Street); (h) Hobson Street (from Union Street to Cromwell Street); (i) Phoenix Street (from Brunswick Street to Hobson Street); (j) Brunswick Street (from Ironmonger Lane to Chaucer Street) and (k) Chaucer Street (from Brunswick Street to Union Street).

The Order will come into operation on the 1st day of August 1970.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing lengths of road affected and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Oldham, between the hours of 8.40 a.m. and 5.30 p.m., Monday to Friday inclusive, until the 4th day of September 1970.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as

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amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the said 23rd day of July 1970, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

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PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Pembroke (Various Roads, Tenby) (Seasonal Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970
