NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1968,
SECTION 94

The County of York West Riding, Public Path Diversion (No. 7) (Town Head Farm, Grassington) Order 1970.

Notice is hereby given that on the 25th June 1970, the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed without modification is to divert a length of the footpath passing through the farmyard of Town Head Farm, Grassington in the Rural District of Skipton, starting immediately south of a newly erected cubicle house and extending north-westwards for a distance of approximately 50 yards.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be in-

spected free of charge at the Council Offices, Granville Street, Skipton, and at the County Hall, Wakefield, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Friday.

This Order becomes operative as from the 25th June 1970, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1968, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may under section 178 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, within 6 weeks from 21st July 1970, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

Survey of Rights of Way

Notice is hereby also given that the said County Council as Surveying Authority have, pursuant to section 32 of the above Act, prepared a Definitive Map and Statement containing the particulars contained in the aforementioned Provisional Map and Statement subject to such modifications thereof as are necessary for giving effect to declarations made by the Court of Quarter Sessions under section 31 of the above Act.

Notice is hereby further given that the said Definitive Map and Statement may be inspected during normal office hours at the Glamorgan County Council Offices, Greyfriars Road, Cardiff. An appropriate extract from the Definitive Map and Statement has also been supplied to each non-county Borough, Urban and Rural District Council in the area covered by the Definitive Map and Statement and such extracts may be inspected during normal office hours and otherwise as stated at the addresses shown below:
