NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The County of Worcester (Bridleway Number 2, Churchill and Blakedown) Public Path Diversion Order 1970.

Notice is hereby given that on 25th July 1970, the Worcestershire County Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert as from the 22nd August 1970, the public right of way at Common Farm in the Parish of Churchill and Blakedown in the county of Worcester running from a point on the Worcestershire/Staffordshire boundary approximately 325 yards north-west of Common Farm buildings in a general southerly direction for approximately 1,040 yards to Rocky Lane approximately 305 yards north-west of its junction with Churchill Lane.

The new route will run from a point on the said boundary approximately 83 yards east of the existing path in a general southerly direction for approximately 1,020 yards to the point of termination at Rocky Lane of the existing path.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Rural District Council Offices, Kidderminster, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. from 7th August 1970.

The Order becomes operative as from 7th August 1970, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act as amended, or of any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within six weeks from 7th August 1970, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
