#### *The National Insurance (Collection of Graduated Contributions) Regulations 1970*

In accordance with section 108 of the National Insurance Act 1965, the National Insurance Advisory Committee give notice that they have received from the Secretary of State for Social Services for consideration and report thereon the preliminary draft of regulations entitled the National Insurance (Collection of Graduated Contributions) Regulations 1970.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations revoke and consolidate with amendments the National Insurance (Collection of Graduated Contributions) Regulations 1960 as amended by the National Insurance (Collection of Graduated Contributions) Amendment Regulations 1962, hitherto in force. The Schedule to the regulations sets out the provisions of the Income Tax (Employments) Regulations 1962, as they apply to graduated contributions, thus providing for graduated contributions to be collected by the Inland Revenue along with P.A.Y.E. These income tax regulations have been further amended and consolidated, and the draft Collection of Graduated Contributions Regulations bring the graduated contributions regulations into line with the consolidated income tax provisions at various points.
