SCHEDULE 3

Temporary Abatement from Daily Rates of Pay for Single Personnel

1. For the period 1st April 1970 to 31st March 1971 only, and subject to paragraph 2 below, the rates of pay of OFFICERS, RATINGS AND OTHER RANKS who were not in receipt of Marriage Allowance or State Supplement on 31st March 1970 shall be calculated by deducting the following daily amounts from the interim rates shown in Schedules 1 and 2:

1. The following allowances shall be abolished as from 1st April 1970:

- (j) Post Mortem Allowance.
- (k) Royal Yacht Allowance.

2. The following revised allowances shall be payable as from 1st April 1970:

(a) Professional Pay for Medical and Dental Officers:

(1) *Consultant Pay* at the following rates shall be payable to Medical and Dental Officers while holding a Consultant appointment or certain appointments determined by the Admiralty Board. Consultant pay shall not normally be payable to officers of Flag Rank.
