NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

West Suffolk County Council (Footpath No. 11 Great Bradley) Public Path Diversion Order No. 1 1970.

Notice is hereby given that on the 3rd day of August 1970, the West Suffolk County Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert a public right of way running across O.S. Plot 104, Great Bradley (i.e., the site of the Clarendale Estate) to a course running along the footways and roads of the estate.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the offices of Clare Rural District Council, Stonehall, Clare, Sudbury, during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from the 10th day of August 1970, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 13th day of August 1970, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

The West Dean Rural District Council (Newland) Extinguishment Order 1970

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on the 30th day of July 1970, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order by the West Dean Rural District Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed, without modifications will be to extinguish:

1. Footpath No. 37 starting approximately 167 yards north-east of Brynna Cross Cottage at its junction with footpath No. 35 and marked F on the map running east for a distance of approximately 459 yards to its junction with footpath No. 36 at a point marked G on the map.
2. Footpath No. 47 starting at a point approximately 100 yards north of Lodges Farm at a point marked K on the map and running generally north-east for approximately 293 yards to a point 40 yards north-west of Valley House marked L on the map.
3. Footpath No. 48 starting at a point approximately 30 yards north-west of the aforementioned point L at a point M on the map and running north-east for approximately 295 yards to its junction with footpath No. 4 and marked N on the map.

The West Dean Rural District Council are satisfied that an alternative right of way is not required.

A copy of the Order and the map contained therein has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Coleford, Glos., between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Clerk of the Council, West Dean Rural District Council, Council Offices, Coleford, Glos., GL16 8HG, before 11th September 1970, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the West Dean Rural District Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Ministry of Housing and Local Government themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Minister any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.

CIVIC AMENITIES ACT 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Burton upon Trent County Borough Council have, as Local Planning Authority, pursuant to section 1 of the Civic Amenities Act, 1967, designated three Conservation Areas. An indication of the lands affected by each such Area is given in the Schedule hereto.
