THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS, 1968

Austria : Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations, 1968, he hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the First Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 17th December 1968, for the importation of meat and meat products from Austria, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 13th March 1970, is hereby revoked.

Imports of uncooked meat and meat products from certain countries are restricted and in some cases prohibited, on animal health grounds by the Importation of Carcasses and Animal Products Order, 1954, as amended. The recognition of an Official Certificate for public health purposes does not give exemption from such restrictions or prohibitions.
