Class or description of vehicle

Passenger Vehicle, that is to say, a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than 12 passengers exclusive of the driver and not drawing a trailer.

Goods Vehicle, that is to say, a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description and is not drawing a trailer.

Invalid Carriage as defined in section 253 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960.

The Borough of Boston (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (No. 4) Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Boston propose to make an Order under sections 28 (1) and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to authorise the use of parts of the roads specified in the Schedule hereto as free parking places for motor cars, motor cycles and invalid carriages between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. The parking period will be 30 minutes in the case of Bridge Street, High Street, Mitre Lane, Red Lion Street, West Street, Wide Bargate and a section of Thorold Street, 2 hours in the case of Fydell Crescent, Norfolk Street, Red Lion Square, Tawney Street, Tunnard Street and a section of Thorold Street, 4 hours in the case of south Square and 8 hours in the case of the Market Place.

The parking places will be available on all days of the week, with the exception of the Market Place, which will be available on days other than market days. The Order will make provision for the removal of vehicles left in a parking place in contravention of the Order.

THE SCHEDULE

Parts of road authorised to be used as a street parking place.

1. Bridge Street south-east side from a point 63 feet south-west of High Street, south-westerly for a distance of 108 feet at a width throughout of 6 feet.

2. Fydell Crescent south side, in a westerly direc-2. Pydelt Crescent south side, in a wester tion from a point:
(a) 99 feet from High Street for 24 feet.
(b) 166 feet from High Street for 24 feet.
