*Thomas Street.*

*Hick Street.*—On its west side—from its junction with Dillwyn Street to its junction with the lane rear of Hick Street.

*Frederick Street.*

*Town Hall Square.*—East and west sides of road rear of Stepney Street between York Hotel and Magistrates Court Offices.

*Union Bridge.*

*Cambrian Street.*

- (a) On its west side—between Union Bridge and its junction with Traeth Ffordd.

- (a) Between its junction with Town Hall Square and a point 90 yards north-west of that junction.
- (b) Between points 137 and 147 yards north-west of its junction with Town Hall Square.
- (c) Between its junction with Pembrey Road and a point 50 yards south of that junction.
- (d) On its north-east side between points 90 and 137 yards north-west of its junction with the Town Hall Square.
- (e) On its south-west side between points 50 and 160 yards south-east of its junction with Pembrey Road.
